Healthy Beginnings Program

HomeSafe is the exclusive entry agency for children birth through five years of age and their families into the Healthy Beginnings System of Care in Palm Beach County.

SERVICES

Outreach

Outreach Educators conduct the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ-3) and the Ages and Stages Questionnaire Social-Emotional (ASQ-SE) with families to screen for possible developmental concerns in children.

Assessment Team

Developmental Consultants assess child development, social-emotional development, behavior, trauma, family relationships, parental stress, and parental depression. Developmental Consultants are then able to make referrals to programs for services.

Navigation

System Navigators provide families that have an infant 0-12 months with a safe place to sleep, along with safe sleep education. They can also assist families in applying for Medicaid and finding a local pediatrician.

Growing Smart

Developmental Support Specialists support children from birth to two years of age and their families with their child's development, household safety education, immunizations, and more.
